INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

AT CALVING TIME. Feed 500 g of Fresh Cow YMCP as soon as possible after calving as follows:

Mix 500 g Fresh Cow YMCP to a minimum of 20 liters of warm water. The quicker the offering of Fresh Cow YMCP in the drinking water after calving the better the consumption.

Mix 500 g Fresh Cow YMCP to 1 liter of warm water and applying with a drench pistol.

STORAGE: Store in a dry room at temperatures between 4°C and 30°C. Keep out of reach of children.

SHELF LIFE: 18 months from date of manufacture when stored under proper conditions.

AVAILABLE PACKAGE SIZES: 10 kg plastic pail (20 bags x 500 g), 12.5 kg plastic pail.
